A Citation is awarded to an individual or team (i.e. academic staff, general staff, sessional staff or institutional associates) who have made a significant contribution to the quality of student learning, in a specific area of responsibility over a sustained period.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMISSION

- Citation Nomination Form
- Claims Against Assessment Criteria
- Team Statement of Contribution For Team nomination only
- Two Letters of Reference
- Digital Photograph

Eligible institutions can submit a maximum of six submissions and the maximum number awarded to each institution is five. In 2023, up to 100 citations will be awarded across the categories below.
