Three reminders are in order:


- In preparation for their nominations, we encourage nominees to watch the invaluable <u>Professional Development Series</u> developed last year. More information provided below.

- Addresses all of the subcategories well and with compelling evidence against each assessment criterion
- Demonstrates sustained commitment and excellence


