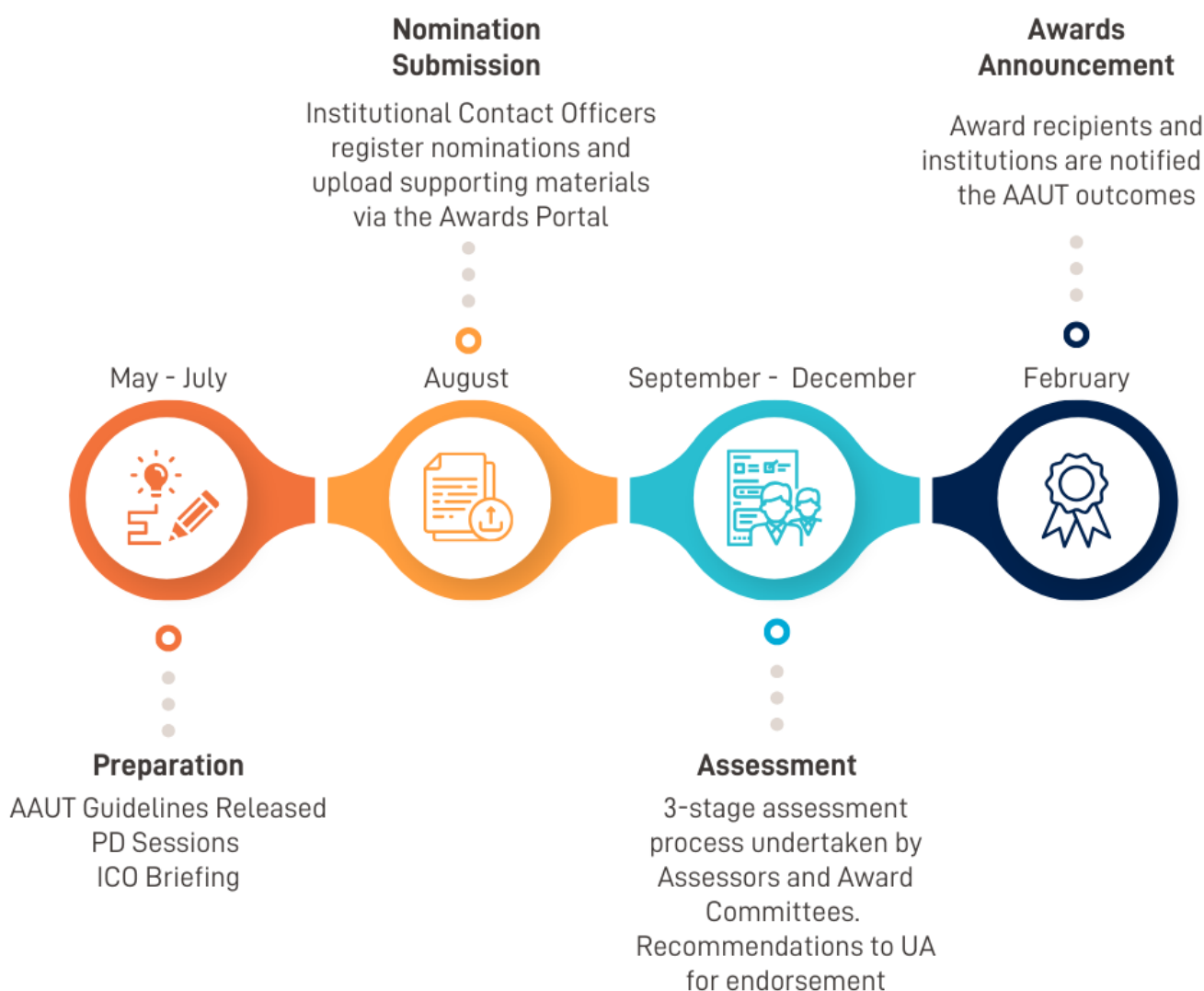

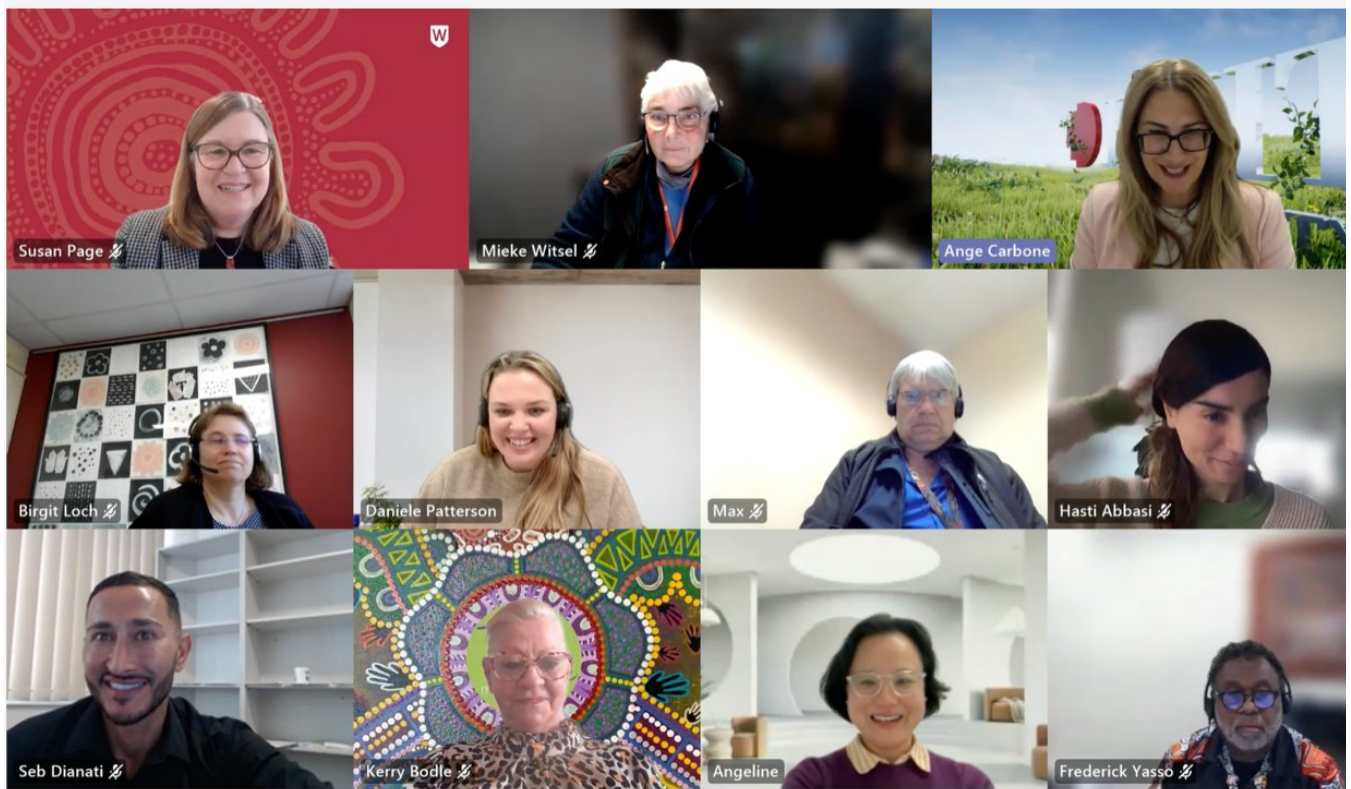
- **ICOs receive Awards Portal Nomination Instructions:** Friday 9 August 2024
